The program provides on-the-job training to learn all aspects of warehousing and supply operations, and off-the-job training to complete a nationally recognised qualification.


What are some of the day-to-day tasks and responsibilities?

- Participation in daily pre-start team meetings.
- Loading and unloading of materials and equipment from vessels, trucks and containers.
- Full suite of warehouse activities such as receipt, storage and, picking and staging of materials and equipment.
- Investigating and resolving system and storage discrepancies.
- Participating in our Perfect HSE Day –
 including identification and reporting of
 hazards, submission of SAFE cards, and
 involvement in site-based safety walks.
- Daily use of computer-based systems including SAP.
- Strict adherence to relevant industry laws and regulations, and company policies and procedures.









Where will you be working?

You'll complete your induction at Woodside's Production Training Academy, based at Karratha Gas Plant. After that, you will then be assigned to a team at Woodside's King Bay Supply Base, where you will learn all aspects of the job while completing the remainder of the traineeship.

What training will be provided?

Over the traineeship you will be provided with:

- Initial on-boarding and training with Woodside's Production Training Academy
- Ongoing support from a dedicated Mentor/Advisor
- Regular training and assessment at North Regional TAFE, as you work towards successful completion of Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations
- Additional training in a variety of safety and trade related modules, including Forklift, and First Aid

What requirements are there to become a Wharf and Logistics Trainee?

- Possess a genuine interest and motivation in pursuing a career within the warehousing and logistics industry supporting the Oil & Gas industry.
- Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.
- Current C class drivers licence.
- Ability to obtain a Maritime Security Identification Card (MSIC)
- The ability to pass a pre-employment medical and attend regular drug and alcohol screens
- A good level of physical fitness and commitment to maintaining their health and wellbeing
