About the role

The Wharf Traineeship is a two-year program, working at the King Bay Supply Base which supports Woodside's Burrup Production Facilities.

The program provides on-the-job training to learn all aspects of warehousing and supply operations, and off-the-job training to complete a nationally recognised qualification.

What are some of the day-to-day tasks and responsibilities?

- Participation in daily pre-start team meetings.
- Rigging store experience, including inspecting and maintaining lifting equipment, forklift operations.
- Loading and unloading of materials and equipment from vessels and bunkering water
- Tie up and let go of vessels at Woodside's dedicated, world class port.
- Investigating and resolving system and storage discrepancies.
- Participating in our Perfect HSE Day - including identification and reporting of hazards, Field Leadership engagement, and involvement in site-based safety walks.
- Strict adherence to relevant industry laws and regulations, and company policies and procedures.



Where will you be working?

You'll complete your inductions at King Bay Supply Facility, after that you will be working alongside the Wharf team, where you will learn all aspects of the job while completing the remainder of your traineeship.

What training will be provided?

Over the traineeship you will be provided with:

- Initial on-boarding and training with Woodside's Production Training Academy
- Ongoing support from a dedicated Mentor/Advisor
- Regular training and assessment at North Regional TAFE, as you work towards successful completion of Certificate III in Supply Chain Operations
- Additional training in a variety of safety and trade related modules, including Forklift, Dogging, Basic Rigging and First Aid

What requirements are there to become a Wharf Trainee?

- Possess a genuine interest and motivation in pursuing a career within the Wharf industry supporting the Oil & Gas industry.
- Identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander.
- Current C class drivers licence.
- Ability to obtain a Maritime Security Identification Card (MSIC)
- The ability to pass a pre-employment medical and attend regular drug and alcohol screens
- A good level of physical fitness and commitment to maintaining their health and wellbeing
