Housing and Community Services (HACS) manages the provision of housing assistance and associated tenancy activities on behalf of the commissioner for Social Housing.

Contract history

In 2018 Programmed was awarded the Total Facilities Management Servies for HACS. The portfolio has approximately 11,700 dwellings and provides accommodation for approximately 23,000 people.

The housing portfolio is dispersed throughout the majority of suburbs in the ACT and has 4 regions:

- Tuggeranong
- Woden
- City
- ▶ Belconnen / Gungahlin.

Notable achievements

Diversity and Social Incusion Program

A key aspect of the contract is Programmed's commitment to Target 5000 - a ten-year Programmed Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Engagement and Employment Plan to employ 5,000 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people at Programmed by 2026.

The Social Inclusion Program implimented to the contract is the first of its kind and demonstrates Programmed's commitment to the belief that everybody has a right to be heard and socially included in a meaningful way.

Our team works closely with Housing ACT and together we have aligned diversity values and have already employed Indigenous people, people with a disability, young people, people from a social housing background and tenants into our team.

Our subcontractors are also engaged in the diversity journey, employing young people and assisting Programmed to meet our social cohort targets. Through employing a new diversity and inclusion specialist, we will be sharing more stories of our new community outreach initiatives with the Programmed team and our external stakeholders.

Value add - ProMAP

Housing ACT was the first of Programmed's social housing contracts to use ProMAP. This provides real-time status updating of work order data from the field.

Having this visibility of asset data is a major step forward along the journey delivering strategic asset management on the contract.
