Facilities and Asset Management

The Hobsonville Point Schools Public Private Partnership (PPP) was the first PPP to be signed in New Zealand in April 2012.

Programmed was part of the winning Learning Infrastructure Partners consortium engaged to design, construct, finance and maintain the new Hobsonville primary and secondary schools.

Contract history

Located west of Auckland, the Hobsonville Point Schools comprise:

- ▶ Hobsonville Point Primary School, Years 1 to 8, with 690 student capacity
- ▶ Hobsonville Point Secondary School, Years 9 to 13, with 1,500 student capacity.

Programmed worked closely with their consortia partners, Morrison & Co (equity and SPV management), Westpac (debt funding) and Hawkins Constructions (design and construction). Programmed implemented maintenance cost efficiencies in the design phase, maximising Whole of Life (WoL) objectives.

This was achieved through:

- Developing an FM Design brief to ensure minimum design and construction standards, minimum warranties, standard asset life and spares schedules were achieved
- Working with the design team during concept design through to detailed design



- Attending construction progress meetings and on-site attendance during the construction phase and commissioning
- ► Early engagement of key staff this provided a smooth transition between construction and operations
- Placement of 1st year maintenance contracts within the design and build contracts, ensuring that contractors who installed items could maintain and repair them in their 1st year of warranty.

Scope of services

The scope of services being provided by Programmed includes:
