The General Service Operator Traineeship gives Traditional Owners, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people the chance to build a career in the energy industry. You'll gain hands-on experience, grow your confidence, and explore real employment pathways while being supported every step of the way.

Based at Woodside's Pluto LNG Park in Karratha, this two-year program combines paid, on-the-job learning with specialist training. You'll work alongside experienced operators and technicians, develop practical skills, and earn a nationally recognised qualification that can open doors to your future in the energy industry.



Your Role as a General Service Operator

You'll be part of the team that keeps the site running safely every day. Your role is hands on and includes:

- **Teamwork and safety** - join daily toolbox talks and pre-start meetings so everyone knows the plan for the day.
- **Helping across site** - support different maintenance and clean-up tasks that keep the site safe and running smoothly.
- **Working with ships** - help prepare the wharf, and assist with tying up and letting go of ships when they arrive or depart.
- **Supporting LNG trucks** - help trucks that come to site to fuel up with LNG (liquefied natural gas).
- **Learning emergency response** - get trained to be part of the team that responds if there's an incident.
- **Checking equipment** — learn how to spot issues, report problems, and make sure everything is safe and reliable.
- **Building a career** — work alongside experienced operators and start your pathway into the Oil & Gas industry.



Skilled for Success Training for your Future

As a General Service Operator, you'll build the knowledge and skills you need to succeed through a mix of specialist and hands-on training:

- **Process Plant Operations Training at ACEPT (South Metro TAFE)** - work towards your Certificate II in Process Plant Operations, with block training in Year 1 and Year 2 to give you the technical foundation for the job.
- **On-the-job learning** - shadow and learn directly from experienced Operators while gaining real site experience.
- **Emergency response training at ERGT (Jandakot)** - become qualified as a Fire Team Member and in Confined Space Rescue.
- **Other industry training in Karratha** - courses including Gas Test Atmospheres, Working at Heights, Enter Confined Space, First Aid, Dogging & Rigging, Forklift, and other industry modules to broaden your skills.



Who Can Apply

This traineeship is open to people who want to start their career in the energy industry - no previous Oil & Gas experience is required. If you bring the right attitude, we'll give you the training and support to succeed.

To be eligible for the General Service Operator Traineeship, you should have:

- An interest in operations, maintenance, and safety.
- Reliability, motivation, and eagerness to learn.
- Year 12 completion (or equivalent).
- A current C class driver's licence.
- Good physical fitness and a strong commitment to safety.
- Ability to pass a pre-employment medical and ongoing drug & alcohol testing.
- Capacity to meet requirements for a Maritime Security Identification Card (MSIC).

This opportunity is open to Indigenous Australians, and we particularly welcome and encourage applications from the local Murujuga language groups - Ngarluma, Yaburara, Yindjibarndi, Mardudhunera, and Wong-Goo-Tt-Oo peoples.
