Woodside Energy's Work Experience Program gives Karratha high school students first-hand experience working at Woodside's world-class operating facilities.



Overview

Our work experience program will provide students with the opportunity to:

- Gain experience and insight into the type of work completed every day at Woodside;
- Learn about different career options at Woodside including maintenance (electrical instrumentation and mechanical fitting), engineering, operations, laboratory, administration, and warehousing and logistics;
- Gain essential work experience;
- Explore their interests; and
- Align their school studies with career aspirations and inform their future career choices.

This is an unpaid work experience opportunity. However, students will be provided with uniforms and PPE.

Dates

The program will run in school holidays. Each placement runs for one week (Tuesday to Friday).

Location

Students will be placed at either Karratha Gas Plant, Pluto Gas Plant or King Bay Supply Base.

Eligibility

Positions are limited. Students are eligible to apply for the Work Experience Program if they:

- Are in year 11 or year 12;
- Are at least 15 years old at time of the work experience placement; and
- Are enrolled at Karratha Senior High School, St Luke's College, or Roebourne District High School.
